



Farm House	
Includes: A kitchen with cook top (no oven), microwave, full-size fridge, coffee maker, outdoor charcoal grill, and fire ring	
Things to Remember to Bring if you are staying in the Farm House (This is not an all-inclusive list but highlights the major items to remember)	
KITCHEN	
	All cooking/serving utensils
	Pots & pans
	Plates, bowls, cups, forks, spoons, knives
	Cleaning supplies, i.e., dish soap/sponge, dish towels,
	Paper towels
	Broom/dust pan
	Trash bags
	Grilling supplies (charcoal, grill tools, foil, matches/lighter etc.)
	Ice chest – We sell ice for your convenience We ask that you only bring aluminum bottles or cans and all alcoholic beverages be kept in a coozie or other container and is not exposed while out and about in the Park
	Firewood – We sell fire wood for your convenience (matches/lighter)
	Roasting sticks for s'mores/hot dogs
BEDDING	
	Full/Queen size fitted sheet and bedding for fold-out bed in the living area
	Sleeping bags
	Extra pillows/blankets
PERSONAL ITEMS	
	Beach towels for pool/water park
	Water shoes
	Swim suit
	All personal hygiene supplies you would normally take on a trip
	Toilet paper is provided
	Jacket/Umbrella
	Anything special you require for a trip away from home
SAFETY	
	Sunscreen
	Bug repellent
	First aid kit (include medicines such as antihistamine or fever reducer, sunburn treatment)
	Medicines such as antihistamine, fever reducer
FUN	
	Fishing poles
	Bicycles/toys - NOTE: We do not permit motorized ride on toys in the park for safety reasons
	Close toed shoes – Some activities require close toed shoes such as tennis/hiking shoes
PET SUPPLIES	
	Make sure you are staying in a pet-friendly cottage and have paid the pet fee (\$25 per pet, per night)
	Pets must be kept in a kennel/crate inside the cottage
	Leash – Pets must be kept on a leash at all times and cannot be left alone/tied up outside your cottage
